Window to the Buddhist World

Thailand has 68 million people. Approximately 1% are believers in Jesus. The Buddhist world has been the most resistant to the spread of the Jesus message, but we are seeing signs of change among young people in the region of Indochina. Media can help them to understand what Christ did for them and what Jesus teachings are all about.

HURRY & APPLY!

Media Light only takes 25 students per school session so don't delay in applying...

In order to keep our quality high Media Light accepts only 25 students per school session. While there is always a chance for a last minute opening it is risky and inadvisable to delay applying. It will take you some time to complete the necessary forms, visa documents and to raise the funds you will need in order to study here. You cannot just show up at the school on your own without completing our admissions process.

Costs

We are running a discount for our first school at a price of only US\$2,500. This includes room, food on campus and tuition for students from developed nations. Students coming from undeveloped nations can avail of a scholarship of US\$1250 toward their fees.

Students are responsible for their own airfares and visa fees and for any expenses incurred off campus.

Students must also pay a refundable equipment deposit of US\$300 to cover any equipment lost or damaged while in their care. Handle the equipment carefully and you'll get it all back when you leave.

Schedule

Students should arrive in Chiang Rai on Sept. 28 and leave Dec.13, 2010. You will be in charge of getting your own visa. Please check the requirements for your country. Thailand is the tourism King of Asia and allows most people to enter as tourists on a two month visa. We can arrange a visa run to the Burmese border to extend for your third month. They may require you to show sufficient cash or credit cards to insure that you will not be a liability on the nation.
